2015 professor for aircraft design at the Institute of Aircraft Design, University of Stuttgart with a research focus on manned (hybrid-)electric flight ("Icaré 2" and "e-Genius") and scaled UAS flight testing. Since 2016 member of the Board of Directors of the European Aeronautics Science Network (EASN). Since 2019 Chairman of the EASN Association.
